 - ProDrenalin
- Photography & Videography 101
 - Composition, coloring & staging
- Lots of sunlight required
 - Small light sensor
- Duration, speed, rotation, motion, music

Which Listings?

No (20%-30% shouldn't)

- Close trees, buildings & other homes
- Overhead wires
- People, highways, full parking lots
- × Airports
- Large acreage
 - Google EarthPro (free)

Yes (30%-40% more could)

- ✓ Large home
 - ✓ Out-buildings
- ✓ Water
 - ✓ Pool, lake
- ✓ Landscaping
 - ✓ Gardens
 - ✓ Tennis/basketball court
- ✓ Adjacent
 - ✓ Golf course or park
- ✓ Large lot, farm, acreage

Checklist to Ensure Great Videos

- ✓ Videos
 - ✓ Not too long
 - ✓ Get the right music
 - ✓ No fast pans or fly-overs
 - ✓ No visible drone shadow or props

Checklist to Ensure Great Aerials

- √ No optical distortion
- √ Sun must shine directly on the primary features
- ✓ The sky must be mostly blue
- ✓ Stage & clean-up the exterior
- ✓ Don't show too much roof
- ✓ Don't take a job too far away
