## 1. Confusion Surrounding LARA License Renewal Communication

This week you may have received two communications from the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA). These communications were intended to notify salespersons and associate brokers of the upcoming renewal period and to familiarize recipients with various online processes within the new MiPlus system. Unfortunately, Michigan Realtors® was not made aware of this communication until after it was sent out.

Based on the volume of calls and emails, the communications have generated a significant

amount of concern from brokers and salespersons alike. One of the main concerns is that salespersons are reading it to say their respective brokerage is in some way behind or not sufficiently engaged in the renewal process. If you received one of these communications, it is important to note that the renewal process is just now beginning, all active brokers have until 10/31/2021 to renew their licenses. We are currently engaged with LARA regarding this communication and will work to prevent this kind of confusion going forward. 


