#### **Scholarship Guidelines**

Must be a full-time student and resident in Michigan, entering junior, senior year or post-graduate work at a university or college.

Must provide a copy of college transcript to date

Must complete and submit application by May 31st for the following academic year.

Incomplete applications are not considered.
